Architecture Sarasota is pleased to present its second annual Phillip Hanson Hiss Dinner on Saturday, March 11, celebrating its 2023 Hiss Award honoree, architect Toshiko Mori. The festivities begin with cocktails and hors d'oeuvres at the Hiss Studio in Lido Shores, to be followed by an elegant candle-lit dinner at neighboring Umbrella House. Toshiko Mori is the Robert P. Hubbard Professor in the Practice of Architecture at Harvard University Graduate School of Design and was chair of the Department of Architecture from 2002 to 2008. She is principal of Toshiko Mori Architect, which she established in 1981 in New York City. Her firm's recent work includes master plans for the Brooklyn Public Library Central Branch and the Buffalo Botanical Gardens; "Thread: Artists' Residency and Cultural Center" in Sinthian, Senegal; "Fass School and Teachers' Residence" in Fass, Senegal; and the expansion of the Brown University Watson Institute for International and Public Affairs.

Ms. Mori's stature in the world of architecture and design makes her a fitting candidate for this award. But it is also for her work in restoring Paul Rudolph's Burkhardt Cohen Residence and for her two sensitively-designed companion structures subsequently built on the Casey Key property that she was chosen as our 2023 Hiss Award honoree. Hiss said, "Think globally, act locally." Ms. Mori and her work embody this beautifully; Architecture Sarasota is delighted to recognize that in bestowing this year's award.

Architecture Sarasota's mission is rooted in Hiss's belief that good architecture can transform places and inspire lives. Because you believe as I do that the organization's mission is essential to retaining the very essence of what makes Sarasota "Sarasota," I hope we can count on your support. Funds raised at the Hiss Dinner will serve to advance Architecture Sarasota's work in many ways, including the launch of several new initiatives.
